The Restos du Cœur begins its annual collection today. Nearly 83,000 volunteers are waiting for you until Sunday in supermarkets all over France to collect your donations of food and hygiene products.

The Restos du Cœur also counts on the sale of the record of the concert of the Enfoirés. The concert will be broadcast tonight on TF1.

The PSG player Achraf Hakimi is indicted for rape. The 24-year-old Moroccan international is placed under judicial supervision. He was heard yesterday by investigators from the Hauts-de-Seine Territorial Security. A young woman in her 20s accuses him of having raped her last Saturday at his home in Boulogne-Billancourt.

And the debates continue in the Senate around the pension reform. Senators have until March 12 to vote on the text. These debates, however, will be much more serene than they were in the National Assembly.

Industrial production is down in France. It fell by 1.9% in January compared to December according to INSEE this morning. This is due to the significant decline in the manufacture of transportation equipment - Particularly in aeronautics and automotive. On the other hand, the manufacture of capital goods increased by 1%, driven by that of computer, electronic and optical products.

And then the 2023 edition of the Nice Carnival was a huge success! The city has unveiled the figures for the two weeks of festivities. This year, the Carnival welcomed 200,000 spectators.
