Emmanuel Macron paid tribute to Gérard Collomb, stating that he has changed his life. The funeral of the former Minister of the Interior is currently taking place in the Saint-Jean Cathedral in Lyon, where he was mayor for almost 20 years. Present during the ceremony, the president praised the strength of soul, the taste for dialogue and the sense of friendship of the man who was one of his first political supporters.

Also in the news: The moment of truth for Eric Dupond-Moretti. The Minister of Justice will know this afternoon whether or not he is convicted of illegal conflict of interest. The Court of Justice will render its decision at 3 p.m. As a reminder, the Minister of Justice was on trial for having taken advantage of his position as minister to settle scores with magistrates. 1 year of a suspended prison sentence was requested against him.

A father is indicted for the murder of his three daughters in Alfortville in Val-de-Marne. The 41-year-old man was placed in pre-trial detention. He confessed to the murders while in custody. The suspect had already been convicted in the past for domestic violence.

And will there be a new extension of the truce between Israel and Hamas? While it was due to end tomorrow, the Palestinian movement says it is ready to extend it for a period of 4 days. Hamas is said to be ready to release new hostages during this ceasefire, in exchange for the release of Palestinian prisoners.

We are one day away from the Cop 28. The international climate conference opens tomorrow in Dubai but with one absentee, that is Pope Francis. The sovereign pontiff cancels his visit for health reasons. He was initially scheduled to give a speech on December 2, for the first participation of a Pope in a COP summit.

And then will the candidacy of the French Alps be accepted for the organization of the Winter Olympics in 2030? The response will be given this evening with the announcement of the cities preselected by the International Olympic Committee. The candidacy of the French Alps is in competition with that of Switzerland and Sweden.
